At least 230,000 people in Canada experience homelessness every year

An estimated 35,000 people experience homelessness on any given night in Canada

People with limited financial resources are at an increased risk of becoming homeless or returning to an abusive or violent relationship.

44% of Violence Against Women's Shelters are full on any given night
